

Community Service (or lunch detention) will involve you spending a part of your lunchtime or recess contributing positively to the College. E.g. tidying the yard or helping a teacher.

Restorative Process involves you sitting down in a Behaviour Support Meeting with those who are affected making sure that together relationships can be reconciled. It can involve an apology and requires forgiveness and commitment from all those affected.

Detentions

ICT/Uniform Detentions at lunchtime

Thursday After School Detention from 3.30 – 4.30pm. Detentions are conducted in WIL011.

Positive Behaviour Support may involve a behaviour card to provide immediate feedback to students after each class and/or an extended plan outlining the support networks and strategies for the student

Suspensions are either an 'in-school suspension' where you are expected to come to school and be under the supervision of your Year Level Coordinator without any contact with any student. 'Out of school suspension' requires exclusion from the College until such a time that you and your parents can meet with the Deputy Headmaster and/or Headmaster to discuss your future education.

Behaviour Tracking is required by staff when issues require further follow up and/or support from members of the College Wellbeing team.
